

## **ESOL Level Classifications**

### **Elementary**

Our Elementary level is designed for beginners. At this level, we aim to develop basic English structure and vocabulary to enable tutees to communicate at a basic level with speakers of English on a number of everyday topics.

### **Pre-Intermediate**

Our Pre-Intermediate level is designed for learners with some prior knowledge of English. This level covers the main structures of the English language, develops our tutees' vocabulary, and enhances their ability to communicate with speakers of English on a variety of topics.

### **Intermediate**

Our Intermediate level is designed for learners who communicate competently with speakers of English. At this level, tutees aim to build their vocabulary range, master core grammatical structures and develop more sophisticated idiomatic expression to communicate more effectively on a range of issues and topics.

### **Upper-Intermediate**

Our Upper-Intermediate level is designed for learners who communicate both competently and confidently in spoken and written form. At this level, tutees focus on developing more complex grammatical structures, building a broader vocabulary base, developing fluency, and becoming sensitive to both register and appropriacy.

### **Advanced**

Our Advanced level provides for fluent speakers of English. Learners explore a broad range of topics. Tutees develop a sophisticated vocabulary base, fine-tuning the four core language skills - listening, reading, writing and speaking. Tutees are encouraged to become more conscious of their own linguistic weaknesses and resolve to make them their strengths. At this level, tutees focus on breadth, variety, accuracy, fluency, style, register and appropriacy.
